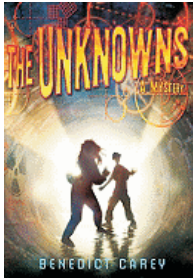

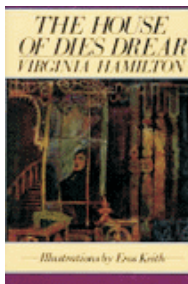


Carey, Benedict. **The Unknowns**

Salim goes up in the ferris wheel but he doesn't come down. He has to be somewhere. Can his cousins find him?

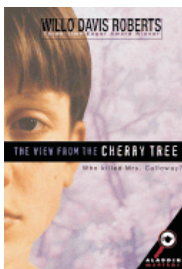


Hamilton, Virginia. **The House of Dies Drear**

When a family moves into an old house they hear mysterious sounds and find hidden passages. The house was used by the Underground Railroad. Could a few ghosts have been left behind?

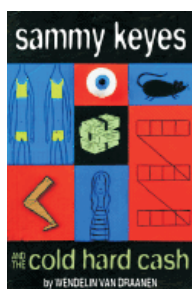
Springer, Nancy. **The Case of the Missing Marquess**
