Reading: If there is a topic your child is interested in like trucks, princesses, or animals, ask a librarian to help you find fun and appropriate books for their age.

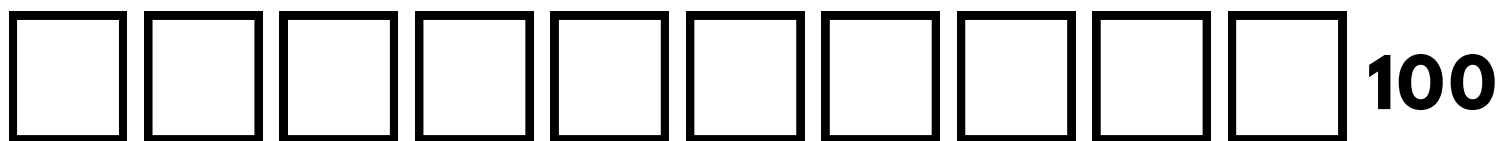
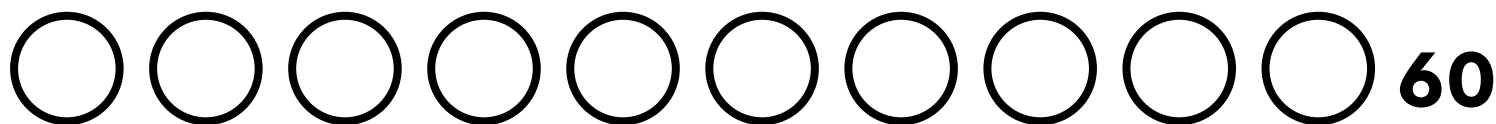
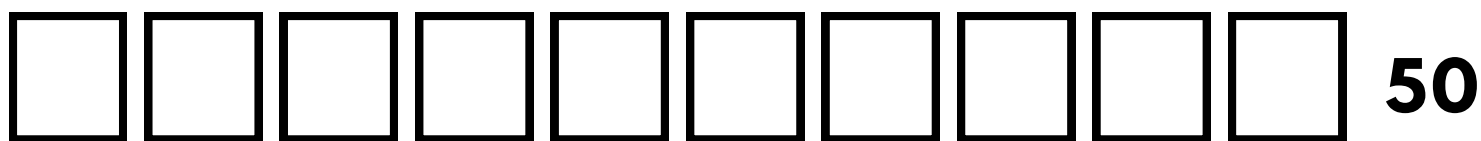
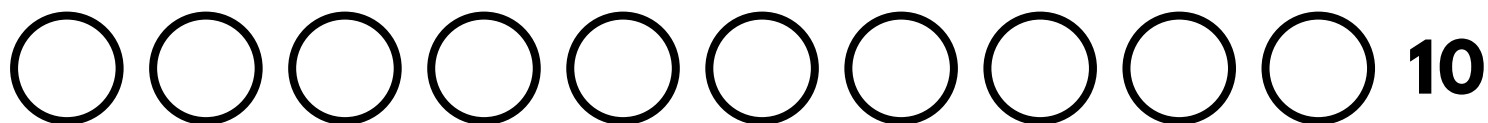
Talking: Talk about the weather and what clothes you might wear if it is hot. What if it was raining or snowing?
